

ADDENDUM NO. 1 Issued February 24, 2015

1. REVISED RFP TIMELINE

By way of this Addendum 1, MIRA is making the following revisions to the timeline for this RFP process wherever such timeline is referenced in the RFP Package Documents:

2. ALTERNATE PROPOSALS TO DELIVER ICW VIA TRANSFER STATIONS

By way of this Addendum 1, MIRA will consider Alternate Proposals from haulers that contemplate deliveries of ICW via the following transfer stations (hereafter the "CSWS Transfer Stations"):

- Essex Transfer Station located on Town Dump Road (off of Route 154), Essex, Connecticut;
- Torrington Transfer Station located on Vista Road (off of South Main Street), Torrington, Connecticut; and
- Watertown Transfer Station located on Echo Lake Road (near exit 37 off of Route 8), Watertown, Connecticut.

Any such deliveries of ICW via a CSWS Transfer Station shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1.1 MIRA requires that Alternate Proposals to deliver ICW via the CSWS Transfer Stations shall be for new increments of acceptable solid waste that has not previously been included in the "put-or-pay" commitment included in Hauler's Connecticut Solid Waste System Solid Waste and Recyclables Delivery Agreement.
- Haulers contemplating the delivery of ICW via a CSWS Transfer Station must submit an Alternate Proposal Price Form (Proposal Form 2a) attached hereto this Addendum 1, in addition to all of the other forms specified in Section 13 of the Instructions to Proposers (Section 2 of the RFP Package Documents).
- 1.3 Haulers may submit an Alternate Proposal Form for the delivery of a minimum of 5,000 tons of ICW annually.

- 1.4 In addition to the Disposal Price ("DP") proposed in the Alternate Proposal Price Form, all ICW delivered by way of a CSWS Transfer Station shall be subject to a \$15/ton Transfer Station Surcharge ("TSS"), such that the total price per ton shall = DP + TSS.
- 1.5 The term "Pricing" as used in Section 15.1 of the Instructions to Proposers shall include only the Disposal Price (not including the Transfer Station Surcharge) for all deliveries of ICW via a CSWS Transfer Station.
- 1.6 If MIRA in its sole and absolute discretion awards an Agreement as a result of an alternate proposal, the following changes will be made to the form of the Agreement (Section 7 of the RFP Package Documents).
 - 1.6.1 Wherever the form of Agreement specifies deliveries to the RRF, the final Agreement will be modified to include deliveries to the designated CSWS Transfer Station.
 - 1.6.2 For the purposes of the order of curtailment detailed in Section 7 of the Agreement, any ICW delivered via a transfer station shall be curtailed based only on the Disposal Price (not including the Transfer Station Surcharge).
 - 1.6.3 Contract Deliveries of ICW delivered via the Transfer Stations shall be tracked separate from ICW delivered directly to the RRF. Shut Out Tons, as specified in Section 7 of the Agreement shall be calculated separately for each type of Contract Deliveries (those via a CSWS Transfer Station vs those direct to the RRF) as shall Hauler's Delivery Payments in accordance with Section 3 of Exhibit C of the Agreement. Hauler's Deivery payments in accordance with Section 3 of Exhibit C of the Agreement shall be based on the Disposal Fee (not including the Transfer Station Surcharge)

ALTERNATE PROPOSAL PRICE FORM (VIA CSWS TRANSFER STATIONS)

This form is for Haulers submitting an alternate proposal that contemplates the use of one of the CSWS Transfer Stations, as specified in Addendum 1 of the RFP.

Notes:

- 1. Exhibit C of the (Form of) Agreement (Section 7 of the RFP Package Documents) specifies four (4) delivery periods and a tonnage of Contract Deliveries for each period, which is subject to the terms and conditions therein. All tons per year which Hauler proposes to deliver via a CSWS Transfer Station by way of this Alternate Proposal Price Form shall be delivered in a manner consistent with the delivery periods specified in Exhibit C of the (Form of) Agreement.
- 2. All tons of ICW delivered via a CSWS Transfer Station by way of this Alternate Proposal Price Form shall be subject to the terms and conditions of Addendum 1 including the Transfer Station Surcharge contemplated in Section 1.2 of Addendum 1.
- 3. ICW deliveries included in this Alternate Proposal Price Form are for deliveries proposed exclusive to this proposal (and any resulting agreement), discrete and separate from any other agreement for ICW or Contract deliveries between the Proposer and MIRA.
